


## How to put a Key Line around your image


Photoshop is really good for adding a Key Line to an image. A Key Line can be really effective in setting a boundary around your image, particularly if your image has a dark background and is displayed on a black screen.


## Here's how to do it:

















**COLOURED KEY LINE FOLLOW THESE** 

Click the **COLOURED** 

This will bring up the **COLOUR PICKER** 

Move your cursor to any spot on the colour picker square and right click to set the colour of your keyline. (You can see the new/current colour

You can change the shade or tone of the **KEYLINE** by clicking on the rainbow

When you are happy with the colour of your keyline click OK on each little window that is open (stroke and colour picker).
